

CERT Meeting Notes, June 12, 2023

This Zoom meeting was called to order by Melissa at 7:30 pm

Attendees were: Melissa, Tim, Rachel, Karen, Mark and City Council liason, Danielle (who left the meeting early)

This meeting was called to officially approve and amend the February Meeting Notes.

Mark read the February Meeting Notes.

Karen moved to make the following addition to these Notes:

We discussed and reached a consensus to try out the Square Space web site for a year at a cost of \$183.17 as a trial. The City's web site has not met our needs in a number of ways.

The motion was seconded by Rachel.

This motion passed 5 to 0.

Melissa moved to make the following addition to these Notes:

We discussed and agreed to send \$20.00 gift cards to Pamela Purvi for the Narcan training she provided and to Margaret Probst for the Stroke Smart training. It was further agreed that Rachel would deliver these gift cards and that CERT would reimburse Rachel for two \$20.00 expenditures.

The motion was seconded by Karen.

This motion passed 5 to 0.

Melissa moved to reimburse Rachel for two Heat Stroke instruction posters, one in English, the other Spanish, at a cost of \$61.99.

The motion was seconded by Karen
This motion passed 5 to 0.

Karen moved to purchase an additional service from Square Space, at a cost of \$60.00 a year, which would improve communications with City residents by automatically notifying them of CERT news and updates.

The motion was seconded by Tim.
This motion passed 5 to 0.

Melissa stated there was \$792.00 left in our budget, part of which we agreed, 5 to 0, to spend on walkie talkies that can reach at least a mile and a half. Melissa and Mark are researching this.

It was agreed that a “FIRST AID” sign was needed to attach to our tents at City events, to identify our location.

It was agreed that a ‘show and tell’ display board would be helpful in spreading CERT related information at City events. Tim and Rachel are researching this.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:30 pm.
